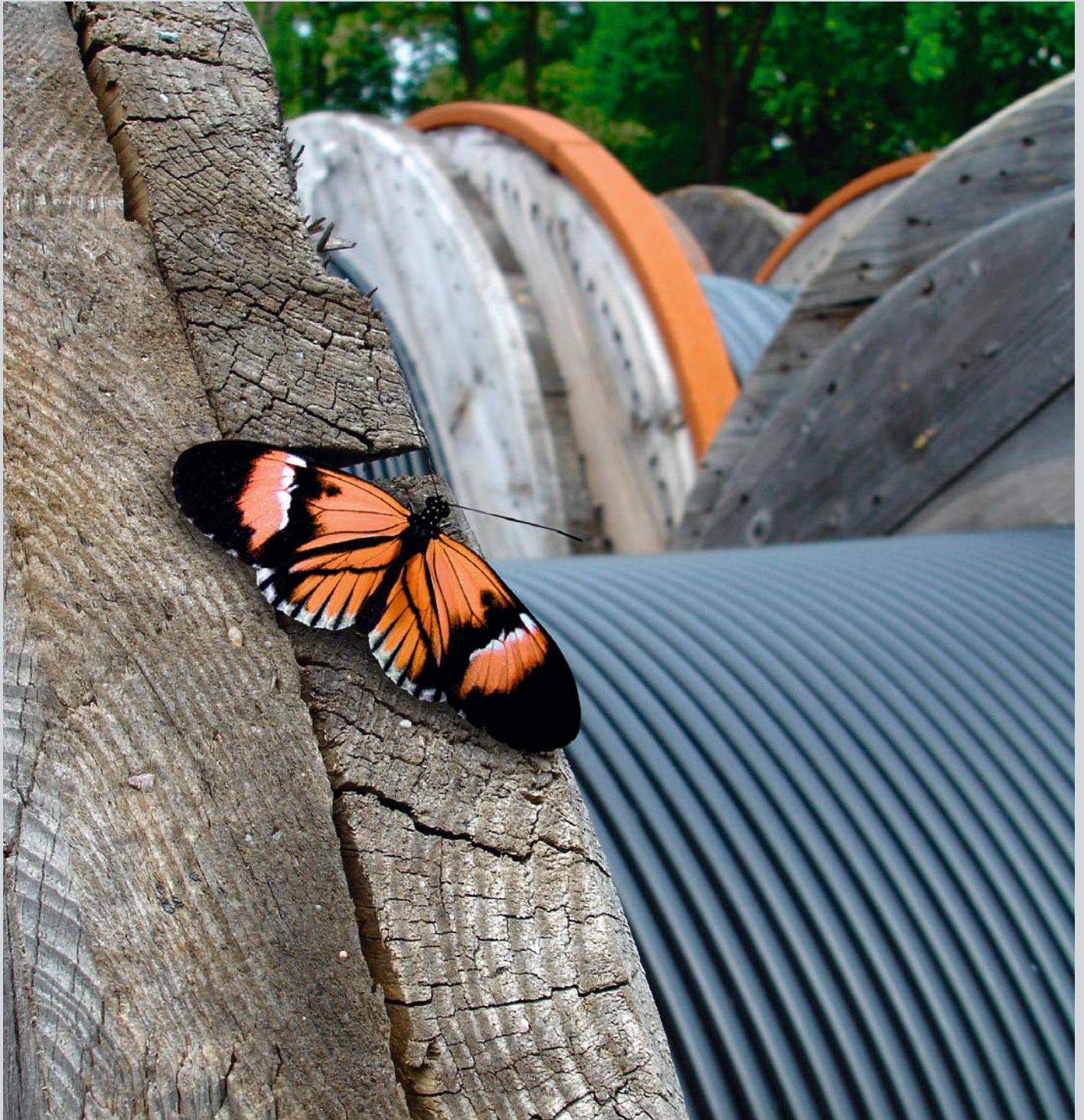

Environment

Environment

As producers of cables and wires we use a large number of basic and working materials. Their careful choice and appropriate application ensures quality, safety and environmental compatibility throughout their lives. New developments in Europe have resulted in a steadily rising awareness for customers and users in the use of environmental materials. As a result, statements on conformance of products to the following European environmental guidelines are ever more often requested.

- EU-Directive 2002/95/EG

(Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment; RoHS). The guideline in effect from 01.07.2006 prohibits the bringing into circulation of products containing lead, cadmium, chrome, mercury or PBB/PBDE.

Decision of the Council to amend the annex of guideline 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and the Council in order to determine maximum concentration limits for certain hazardous materials in electrical and electronic goods - respectively 0,1 percent by weight of lead, mercury, chrom VI, PBB and PBDE, and 0,01 percent by weight of cadmium - for each homogenous material - 10 March 2005 WEEE and RoHS Newsletter from January 2005

- EU- Directive 2002/96/EC

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment; WEEE. From 13.08.2005 producers of electrical and electronic equipment (with the exception of cable producers) are obliged to finance the taking back, disposal and recycling of this equipment with provision for all materials and preparations named in guidelines 6/769 and 67/548

- EU-Directive 2003/11/EG

24th amendment of guideline 76/769EEC on the restrictions on bringing into circulation and use of certain materials and preparations - Ban of PBB and PBDE from 15.08.2004.

- Guideline 76/769/EEC

Restrictions on bringing into circulation and use of certain hazardous materials and preparations - ban on all materials and preparations named in annex 1 of guidelines 76/769 EEC und 67/548.

As a production company in the metal and plastic processing industry, we are aware of our responsibility to the environment and concerned ourselves with this topic at an early stage. The compliance with the named restrictions is carried out at Draka Comteq Berlin via a computer data logging system, which in cooperation with suppliers of basic and working materials, allows an exact product-related register of all certified raw materials according to the guidelines referred to above.

Draka Comteq Berlin established conformance to the stated guidelines as early as 01.07.2005 and is certified by LGA Intercert according to DIN 14001.
